

# PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

We don't have all the numbers in yet but I am going to tout this year's Winter Sectional as a success. One of the primary goals of our Unit is to get more people involved in duplicate bridge and then keep them involved. To that end we offered a \$5 coupon to non-life masters for each session of the sectional. They took advantage of our offer and we averaged 10 ½ tables in our 499er games in each session.

I would like to attribute most of that success to the BCNC (Bridge Club of North County). Bill Butler, Vic Pitcock and Hazel Turner have continually offered EasyBridge! lessons and intermediate bridge lessons. Sue Compton and Vic have promoted and coordinated a mentoring program that has been wildly successful to the point where they are having trouble finding enough mentors. And the BCNC has offered more 199er and 499er games to get our new bridge players involved in duplicate bridge.

The success that the BCNC is having is demonstrated by their table count number. For 2016 the ACBL reported that the BCNC ranked 143rd amongst all of the clubs with a table count of 3154. Those numbers went up in 2017 to a rank of 121st and a table count of 3550. Clearly a job well done by the Board and volunteers at the BCNC.
