District 17, which is part of our Western Region, actually went bankrupt, which has played a role in discontinuing the Forum as a print edition.

I'm sure my wife would like a little less bridge and a little more yard work out of me. And that thought makes me appreciate all the more that there is a bridge game within 20 miles of my house every day of the week. And it makes me appreciate all the more the volunteers we have that keep our costs down and duplicate bridge readily available.
