Our weekly bridge workshops continue as follows: November 29<sup>th</sup>, Managing the Trump Suit; and December 6<sup>th</sup>, Putting It All Together. There will be a short hiatus through the holidays, and then the next

8-week series will begin on Thursday, January 10<sup>th</sup>. This next series will focus on defense. The overwhelmingly positive feedback from our "Mixed -Up Pairs" game in September has prompted the club to organize a new program of individual mentoring based on that format. It will be offered for the Tuesday morning Open game. This is a 'golden opportunity" for newer players who would like to "play up" with a more experienced player and for experienced players who would enjoy helping a newer player transition into more advanced games. Mentor players are invited to play free, junior partners pay their own regular game fee. Partnerships will be arranged according to MP levels. Neither partner will be obligated to a long-term relationship – individuals decide how long they will play together.
