PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Happy New Year!!!

As that singer-songwriter, Bob Zimmerman, so famously wrote "the times they are a-changin". And so it is with Unit 549 for this new year. As I reported last month the rent for the Pavilion at Lake San Marcos has been raised to \$500 per Saturday, which is beyond our means. We have been looking for a new place, but that has had its challenges. We needed to find a place that we can rent for under \$200. We needed a place that can store our tables and equipment or has their own. We needed a place to accommodate a minimum of 22 card tables with room to move around. We needed to find a place that has adequate parking and easy access. And we needed to get this done quickly.

The place we found that was the best fit for all of our criteria is the BCNC (Bridge Club of North County) facility. And best of all, most of you are already familiar with it. The Board met on January 14th and agreed that we would enter a contract with the BCNC for 2018 and that our first unit game will be there on Saturday, February 24. As in the past our unit games will be held on the fourth Saturday of each month with a couple of exceptions (usually May and November).

Unfortunately, this isn't the end of our space challenges. We have plans to hold a Non-Life Master Sectional again this year and need to find a place. While we are covered for our Winter Sectional this year, we need to find a suitable place for next year. And we have a commitment from Audrey Grant to do her very popular and successful 2 day seminar again next year which we will need a space for. The good news is we still have a little time to solve these space issues.

GOLD at the CLUB

An ACBL-wide Regional Event At the Club House (REACH) will be held February 3 and February 5-9 during the afternoon's sessions of club play. This event is open to all ACBL members. Play will be conducted using the electronic hand files provided for 'The Common Game'. Players playing any two or more sessions of this event will be eligible for overall rankings. Players will be ranked as individuals. Sessions scores will be based on percentages.

This event is NOT stratified. Participating clubs will be grouped for overall rankings based on the 'strength of field' algorithm as determined by The Common Game and applied to the individual club results submitted. There will be 4 groups for scoring purposes.

AWARD EXAMPLE

Assume 4,000 participants, 1,000 per pool.

Then the awards would be approximately as follows:

1st Pool - 30.00 Gold for 1st - 0.69 Gold for 250th place

2nd Pool - 24.00 Gold for 1st - 0.55 Gold for 250th place

3rd Pool - 19.20 for 1st (12.67 Gold) - 0.44 for 250th place (0.30 Gold)

4th Pool - 15.36 for 1st (7.68 Gold) - 0.36 for 250th place (0.18 Gold)

Entry fee is \$30 per player. Registration shall be open from January 10 until 2400 PST February 2, 2018. Players must pay both the entry fee and their normal club entry fees. Those interested in participation must register on-line with the ACBL. Use the following link.

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Remember way back when? It's actually getting to the point where that's all most of us can remember anymore. Well, way back when, my parents were part of a social bridge group that got together one Saturday evening a month to play bridge. And I always loved the two or three Saturday evenings a year when it was my parents' turn to host the group. My Mom bought (think Brach's Bridge Mix) or made some really incredible bridge snacks for the evening event. Of course, those snacks were off limits for us kids until Sunday. I'd check in on their bridge game a couple of times during the evening, mostly to see how the snack inventory was holding up. Admittedly, those leftover snacks on Sunday were more interesting than bridge, but I actually cultivated my interest in bridge then.

I started playing bridge in high school, but my serious interest in bridge developed in college. There was always a bridge game or two or three going on in the RathSkellar at the student union, and that posed a problem for me. The big decision for that day was, do I cut the bridge game, or do I cut class? My long college career is a testimonial to that decision.

My partner and I actually got good enough that we started to play duplicate bridge in sanctioned games. And we had a fair amount of success. So at the end of each session, we'd have to hang around to get our master point slip. Remember, this was before computers so everything was done by hand. The director would fill out a slip with your name, ACBL number and relevant sanction information, and put the master point award in a box at the bottom of the slip. It was the players' responsibility to send those slips to the ACBL.

I still have a few of those slips laying around in my memorabilia box, so I can tell you that getting a master point award of .2 or .3 was a big deal way back then. You can imagine how surprised I was when I started playing bridge again and discovered a good day will get you 2 or 3 or 4 master points. Well, the ACBL has taken note of that also. They recently decided to limit the number of "charity" games a club can hold. So if you notice there are fewer games with the larger master point awards that is why.

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

When my children were growing up, I got involved in the parent-run swimming and hockey programs they participated in. My two biggest takeaways from being involved were: there is always more to the program than you expected, and volunteers are the backbone for success. My experience with duplicate bridge hasn't been any different.

Over the course of the past few months, I've had opportunities to interact with many of the local Unit Presidents, our District 22 President, and our National Rep. David Lodge. At the local level, their story is very similar to ours: keeping turnout up, controlling costs, and that constant quest for new members. Not surprisingly, these issues dominate much of the discussion at the District and National levels.

One of the primary responsibilities at the District level is to schedule and run the District's regional tournaments. Ron Lien has set getting locations and contracts for the 5 District Regionals through 2020 as one of the District's priorities. This may be more challenging than you might expect because of rising space costs. The District Board raised card fees at the Regionals to \$14 to keep pace with these rising costs.

At the National level, they have established a target of increasing membership by 15,000 in 2018. This is a huge challenge in my opinion, and a challenge we very desperately need to meet on an ongoing basis for the survival of the game at a level that gives all of us opportunities for regular competitive play.

There should be no secrets at the bridge table. Everyone is entitled to whatever information is needed to understand the bidding. Everyone should be aware that a failure to Alert can have penalty consequences. For a full explanation of Alert Procedures, please visit the ACBL website at: acbl.org Scroll to the bottom of the Home page and under the Tournaments section, choose: Charts, Rules and Regulations. On that page, scroll down again and select the green button that says Alert Procedures.
