### LET'S KEEP THE GAME MOVING

The bidding is done and you are on lead. Instead of picking a card, you enter the contract in the BridgeMate and then into your convention card. Only then do you review the bidding and work on choosing an opening lead. What's wrong with this picture?

As the games gets slower, interest wanes and minds begin to wander. Distractions pop up east, west, north, and south. What's going on at that table across the room. Before you know it the round is called and a late penalty is assessed.

Let's do things in the correct order. Make your opening lead and then do your paperwork. Bridge is a timed event (in most places). Late play is not usually tolerated and is unappreciated by most of the players in the room. The same applies at the end of the hand. Score it up and play the next board. There's plenty of time to talk later

Enuf said, keep the game moving.

### PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

### BETTIE MESSER HELDRING December 1918 – JULY 2014

Bettie Messer Heldring joined the ACBL in 1948. She moved from Kansas City to Escondido in 1968. At that time bridge in San Diego County was a cottage industry. Then the ACBL sanctioned games in peoples' homes. There was a game at the Senior Center in Escondido on Friday nights. The players were expected to set up and put away the tables and chairs. They were also expected to bring in new players.

In 1969 Unit 531 Oceanside – Vista – Escondido became a formal entity with a Board of Directors and Bettie Messer as the First Unit President 1969-70. Bettie took a gamble in 1971 and organized and funded (the Unit had no money) the first Unit Sectional which was held at the Rancho Bernardo Swim & Tennis Club. There was no meal provided between sessions. Bettie asked unit members to bake and provide cookies as snacks. (Excerpted from BRIDGE MEMORIES by Rex Latus.)

It was a pleasure to know Bettie, play bridge as her partner, play bridge as her opponent, bring her into my family, and become part of hers. She was a fierce competitor, a mentor and my friend. Rex and I first met Bettie (and you'd better spell it with and "ie" and not a "y") about 40 years ago when we started playing duplicate. We kids (and she always called us that) were petrified! Bettie was already an icon in the North San Diego County bridge scene. Whenever we played against her, she was polite and encouraging. Somehow we managed to lose our anxiety, not that we did well, but her warmth and smile made our bad boards a little less painful.

Years later, after we retired, Rex and I played regularly play with Bettie on Mondays and Fridays. We had a good time and played for 8 or so years until she "fired" me. I guess I got too aggressive and she did not appreciate some of my criticism. We remained friends and she was included in my family celebrations on Christmas and Thanksgiving. She loved my cranberry chutney and the gravy I made for my tofurky eaters.

I will miss your graciousness, your insight, and your wonderful stories of bridge of years past. Enjoy your heavenly games with John and Barry. We are going to miss you! Rest in peace.

But what I really mean is the spirit of Bridge that is catching on as our little club expands and the doors stay open to friendly competition.

Used to be that folks would come up the hill and gather master points like picking grapes off our vines, but that just added to the "why" factor. (We bottle the "whine.") What we really wanted to know is how they did it. We were coasting along, feeling like a fifty percent game was a laudable goal, and then – oops, we figured out we weren't so hot after all. Our Mary Ann was shooting much, much higher – and with no pointy hat or magical broomstick!

That's when our esteemed player-teacher Geof Applegate started organizing the mysteries and magic of bidding into a semblance of understandable charts and chants. Whosh! We started an uphill surge that has us thinking those fifty-percenters may not be us! In fact, they may be getting a good dusting from the eight ways we've learned to answer a major opening, or the splinters we've caught that have nothing to do with broomsticks! Spirit-in-the-sky!

The After-School Youth Bridge welcomed Wyatt, a quick-learner, and now we're exploring what other youth Bridge groups are doing, especially with Marge Van Hemert and her fourth graders in Bonita. Raising their test scores is just one aspect of her program as she keeps expanding her groups.

ACBL is worried about the average age of club players and fearing a die-out in the next generation. Encouraging youth to play bridge when there are so many other things competing for their attention is no easy feat. However, it won't be long before our kids are ready for some friendly competition. Any more youth clubs out with the same spirit? Let us know!
